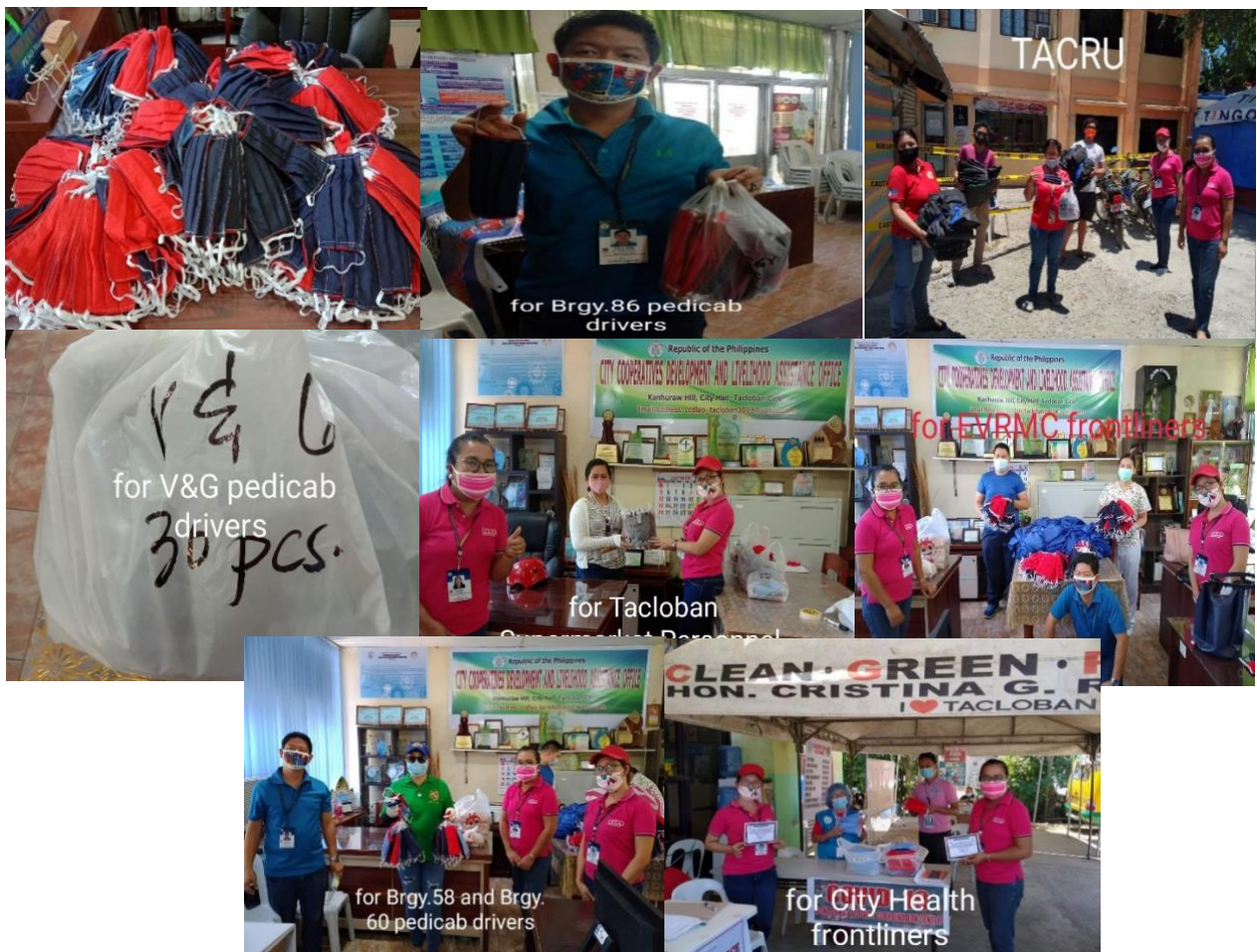


**COOPERATIVES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY GOING THE EXTRA MILE TO
SERVE THEIR MEMBERS AND COMMUNITIES AMIDST COVID-19
PANDEMIC: REPORTS FROM REGION 8

The following cooperatives continued to spread goodwill through the provision of assistance to members, frontliners, and their community:

- NIA Employees Multipurpose Cooperative (NIAEMPC) contributed to the fund mobilized by City Cooperative Development and Livelihood Office (CCDLAO) for PPE production
- Regional and Central COMELEC Employees Multipurpose Cooperative (RECEMPCO) contributed to the fund mobilized by CCDLAO for PPE production
- Department of Agriculture Regional Employees Multipurpose Cooperative (DAREMCO) Contributed to the fund mobilized by CCDLAO for PPE production
- San Jose Parish Hinundayan Multipurpose Cooperative (SJPHMPC) utilized eight hundred thousand pesos (Php 800,000) from their CDF and gave assistance to the PNP and DOH personnel assigned in the checkpoints.



- Metro Ormoc Community Multipurpose Cooperative (OCCCI) distributed/provided bottled water, coffee and biscuits to frontline-members.
- Abuyog St. Francis Xavier Credit Cooperative (AFCCO) provided food packs to the 4 units of Brgy. Buntay Tacloban San Jose Airport Operators and Drivers Transport Cooperative (TSJAODTC) that have been operating daily trips. These are two(2) units in the morning (7am to 10 am) and two (2) other units in the afternoon (3pm to 5pm).
