

COOPERATIVES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY GOING THE EXTRA MILE TO SERVE THEIR MEMBERS AND COMMUNITIES AMIDST COVID-19 PANDEMIC: REPORTS FROM THE CARAGA REGION

Assistance given by cooperatives always comes from the heart, the reason why there is a continuous outpouring of support and encouragement from the cooperative sector. In Caraga Region, cooperatives located in far flung areas are a big help in providing the basic needs not only of their members but also of their community and frontliners

Anolingán Esperanza Socialized Transformation Economic Process (ESTTEP) Multipurpose Cooperative, made house-to-house distribution of food packs to its members.



Agusan del Sur Farmers Producers Cooperative (AFPC) distributed face masks and soap to 48 members and 2 coop staff. 10 kilos of rice were also given to each of the 7 feedmill operators of the cooperative. Amount spent from CDF is Php 4,800.00.

Utilizing also their Optional and Community Development Funds, the cooperative distributed 300 rice packs to non-members amounting to Php51,250.00 and a total of 25 sacks of rice amounting to Php52,500.00 was donated to the CDC-Bislig.

DARBECO members sew PPEs for frontliners. The



materials were from the DTI while the labor cost is from the cooperative which they paid at 100 pesos per piece.

As of today they have finished a total of 85 pieces and delivered to DTI the finished PPEs for distribution.
