

COOPERATIVES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY GOING THE EXTRA MILE TO SERVE THEIR MEMBERS AND COMMUNITIES AMIDST COVID-19 PANDEMIC: REPORTS FROM **REGION 4-B OR MIMAROPA**

Santa Cruz Credit Cooperative, Santa Cruz, Marinduque, being one of the financial institutions involved in lending, is committed in its mission to cooperate with the government & other cooperatives for the attainment of a common goal of uplifting the lives of its people in compliance with the Bayanihan Act. The activities carried out by the coop during this time of pandemic are the following:

- a. Release of Patronage Refund to its 245 members, the total amount of which is P660,000.00;
- b. Participation in the bloodletting program held on April 16, 2020 at Santa Cruz Municipal Gymnasium;
- c. Grant of one (1) month moratorium of payment to members in order to alleviate their lives during these most trying times. The total amount granted is P500,000.00; and
- d. As an act of gratitude to the front liners during this time of pandemic, the cooperative allotted the amount of P20,000.00 from the Community Development Fund (CDF) for the food packs of 150 front liners of the municipality.



The **Palawan Entrepreneurs Multipurpose Cooperative** of Aborlan, Palawan used its Community Development Fund (CDF) for the benefit of the front liners in a number of checkpoints in the Municipality. Meals and bottled water were distributed to our Covid-19 heroes.



Coron School of Fisheries Multipurpose Cooperative of Brgy. Poblacion 1, Coron, Palawan donated 2 sacks of rice and a box of sardines and distributed repacked goods to cooperative members and staff.



Irawan Transport Cooperative, Brgy. Irawan, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan, gave cash donation to its 70 members who are operators and drivers.

Roxas Palawan Municipal Government Employees Multi-Purpose Cooperative, Roxas, Palawan distributed grocery packs to its members who are all government employees unable to receive Social Amelioration Fund from DSWD.
