

The Frontliners Shopping Privilege at Baymart Stores by St. Vincent Coop aims to give our Frontliners time to buy their personal needs as they harrow out and do their jobs from May 1, 2020 to May 31, 2020.

Frontliners are who deliver care at the frontline to protect the community from COVID-19. This includes Doctors, Nurses, Midwives, Medical Technologists, Pharmacists, Ambulance Drivers, Hospital and Clinic Aides, PNP – Uniformed and Non-uniformed Personnel, Bureau of Fire Protection, Phil. Coast Guard, Military, BHERT.

- Express lane will be provided for this purpose. Discount will be given up to a maximum purchase of Php5,000 in a single purchase per day of basic needs.
- Present the following Identification Card:
 - Agency / Company ID
 - Inter-Agency Task Force IDAvalimut of the privilege is personal and is non-transferable, subject to verification.
- We hope that through this privilege, we are able to help and give back to our heroes fighting the COVID-19.
