





- Member co-ops' Gender Program may be funded by the 10% allocation of the local CETF; if not enough, Cooperative Development Fund may be used







2014


- Amendment to MASS-SPECC Election Guidelines to include in the qualification requirements under CDA MC 2013-22 of all candidates: the GAD Program implementation of the primary they are representing
- Gender Equality Committee of MASS-SPECC must be represented by both male and female effective 2014, based on the guidelines [members appointed by the Regional Steering Committee (RSC)]


















> Gender indicators (for co-operative standards) are also part of the Capacity Assessment Tool under the MASS-SPECC Capacity Building Program for Co-operatives.
