## **Section 3. Definition of Terms:**

**(a) Business Entities refers to sole proprietorships duly registered with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), partnerships duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), corporations duly organized and existing under Philippine laws, electric cooperatives registered under NEA, or cooperatives governed RA 9520 otherwise known as the Cooperative Code of the Philippines, as amended; or Microfinance Non-government institutions as governed by RA 10693 otherwise known as the Microfinance NGOs Act**

## Sec. 2 Definition of Terms

**(e) Micro, small, and medium-scale enterprise (MSME)** refers to any business activity or enterprise engaged in industry, agribusiness and/or services, excluding bank and other financial institutions under the supervision of BSP, whether self-employed professional, sole proprietorship, cooperative, microfinance non-governmental organization, partnership or corporation whose total assets, inclusive of those arising from loans but exclusive of the land in which the particular business entity's office, plant, and equipment are situated, must have a value falling under the following categories:

<b>Micro</b>	-	Php 999,000
<b>Small</b>	Php 999,001	Php 99,000,000
<b>Medium</b>	Php 99,000,001	Php 1,499,000,000
