



DE LA SALLE CREDIT COOPERATIVE SHOWS ACT OF COMPASSION BY REACHING OUT TO THE COMMUNITY AND ITS MEMBERS

De la Salle University, Manila. The De la Salle Credit Cooperative (DLSCC) initiated series of programs and activities despite the whole National Capital Region (NCR) and other areas of Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine during the previous months. Amongst these are the following:

- Provided food (not limited to bread, biscuits, coffee and energy drinks) to 80 homeless individuals with the aid of a co-sponsor (De la Salle University- Manila and De la Salle College of St. Benilde) amounting to Php. 30,000.00.
- Donated 15 cavans of rice to external service personnel who are on a no work, no pay arrangements with the aid of a co-sponsor (De la Salle- Zobel) amounting to Php. 30,000.00.
- Supported the financial assistance program given by co-sponsor institution (De la Salle Dasmariñas) for non-compensated external service providers amounting to Php. 30,000.00.
- Supported the financial assistance program of co-sponsor institution (De La Salle-Medical and Health Sciences Institute) for 120 personnel (janitors, security guards, custodians, and maintenance personnel) amounting to Php. 30,000.00.
- Initiated a provision for financial assistance to front liners of co-sponsor institution (De La Salle-Araneta University) amounting to Php. 30,000.00.
- Donated to DLSU Safe Shelter Program for front liners (nurses) from the Philippine General Hospital amounting to Php. 100,000.00.
- Contributed to the Lasallian Cares Program to support the external service personnel, concessionaires and construction workers of co-sponsor institution also amounting to Php. 30,000.00.

All programs were approved by the Board of Directors. Besides these, the cooperative continued to work from home (WFH) and ensure that they can provide the credit needs of their members. They have opened new loan windows specifically emergency loans to assist members and their families and also online learning of their children.

Notwithstanding the current pandemic, cooperatives like De la Salle Credit Cooperative (DLSCC) are finding ways to help their members and the community as well.
