

GEMSC assists flood victims within its area of operation

Last January 1 and 8, 2021, the whole City of Silay was hit by heavy rains which led to massive flooding affecting most of the residents of the city. Notwithstanding the fact that there is still fear brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic, the residents of Silay City were in deep trouble and anxiety as yet they were faced with another disaster.

GEMSC otherwise known as the Government Employees Multi-Purpose Cooperative of Silay City is a cooperative situated in Barangay 1 Poblacion, Silay City, Negros Occidental. GEMSC operates within the said area and as part of their social responsibility to the community, initiated a way and linked with the barangay officials to help ease the anxiety of the residents and also lessen the burden brought by the flooding.



On January 11, 2021, in coordination with local officials and also together with the relief goods distribution of the city, GEMSC was able to give out rice packs (two-kilo rice) to a total of 111 affected families of Barangay 1. The Officers and staff of the cooperative assisted in the distribution of the said goods.



This is GEMSC's way of extending assistance to the people in the community and also to encourage them to rise up amidst the catastrophe and challenges that they may face.
