## Project Info

The project is being funded by Republic Act No. 11203, specifically under Section 13 on the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund which was credited to a Special Account in the General Fund of the National Treasury.

The budget from the Philippine Center for Postharvest Development and Mechanization (PhilMech) was transferred and incorporated in the 2021 CDA budget, amounting to Thirteen Million Pesos (P13,000,000.00).

## Beneficiaries

The Project refers to the physical or virtual conduct of capability enhancement activities such as trainings and/or learning sessions for the Farmers' Cooperative and Association (FCA)-recipients of the RCEF-Mechanization Program.
