Objectives

To determine the level of adherence to ethical standards and the level of spirituality among cooperatives management students

Highlights

revealed that cooperatives Results management had average level of adherence to ethical standards among cooperatives management students whether taken as an entire group or classified according to sex, year level, and family and high level of adherence average income to to spirituality level. No significant diferences were noted in the level of adherence to ethical standards among cooperatives management students when grouped according to the differenct categories. Significant differences were noted in the level of spirituality of the students when grouped according to sex and year level, but no significant difference was noted when they were grouped according to family income.

Recommendation

1. Students should continue their adherence to ethical standards and spirituality and practice them in everyday life.

2. The faculty and staff should be good examples of those who follow rules and regulations and the law of God.

3. The institution may conduct several activities for the students to nurture their personal growth and development as well as their spiritual being.

4. Other researchers in the future may conduct studies related to the present investigation.
