Class Period:Preference among College of Business and Management Students

Objectives

To determine the class period preference of the College of Business and management students of West Visayas State University

Highlights

The study revealed that the Tuesday and Thursday 10:00 – 11:30 a.m. Were the most preferred class days of the College of Business and Management Students. They liked mid-day class sessions and two straight periods follwed by a vacant period. The least preferred class days by CBm students were Saturday 5:30 – 7:00 pm class period, evening class session and four to six straight periods followed by a vacant period.

Recommendation

1. Students must learn to manage their time well. Results could be used to identify time where one could work well.

2. Faculty member should be aware of the time preferred by students to work, so they can schedule work accordingly.

3. Parents need to give necessary support to their children in school so that at times when they want to work, they can be productive.

4. Future researchers could conduct further studies related to the problem of this study in other contexts.
