Objectives

The major objective of the study was to know the Perceived Effects of Multi-Purpose Cooperatives to Social and Economic Status of Members in the City of Cabuyao. Other objectives were to see the level of the perceived effects of multi-purpose cooperatives to social and economic status of members and to determine the awareness of the members of the multi-purpose cooperatives to different social and economic effects.

Highlights

Results of the study revealed that respondents agreed to high level of perceived effects of multi-purpose cooperatives to their social and economic status. Most of the respondents who were members of multi-purpose cooperatives in the City of Cabuyao were females and married with age brackets of 31-40 years old. Majority of the respondents were college graduates and members of cooperative for more than five years now. There were significant differences in terms of age, educational attainment and length
