Objectives

To determine the organizational commitment among cooperatives to their allied federation in Iloilo.

Highlights

1. The member cooperatives were highly committed to the allied federation as assessed by the managers taken as an entire group and when classified according to age, sex, educational attainment, and length of services.
2. There were no significant differences in the organizational commitment of member cooperatives to their allied federation as assessed by the manager clasified to age, sex, educational attainment, and length of service.

Recommendation

1. The organization should be aware that organizational commitment contributes to the creation of a motivational organization climate in the cooperative that results to the productivity.
2. The secondary cooperatives can also evaluate and be aware of their organizational commitment to their members-cooperatives. Through this, there will be harmony in their cooperative and information about their goals and objectives can be easily achieved.
3. The results of the study will give knowledge to cooperatives management students about how important organizational commitment is in a cooperative or in any type of business and how this greatly contributes to its productivity.

4. Future researchers should conduct more studies about the organizational commitment with different types of cooperatives or business.

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
