### 1. Registration

The year 2020 brought an increase of 42 newly registered cooperatives. As of December 31, 2020, there are 1,943 registered cooperatives in Region VII.

This number of registered cooperatives are established in the following provinces: Bohol - 658, Cebu - 999, Negros Oriental - 177 and Siquijor - 66.

### COOP SEED BENEFICIARY IN THE FRONTLINE FOR WELLNESS: VALENCIA DAIRY COOPERATIVE

Micro cooperatives like Valencia Dairy Cooperative (VADCO) of South Poblacion, Valencia, Negros Oriental is one of the cooperatives that were given series of capacity building seminars in 2018-2019 under the CDA-DTI COOP-SEED Partnership Program. The training equipped the officers and members to become farmer-entrepreneur vis à vis provided the opportunity for the cooperative to serve as the marketing channel of the products produced by the farmers.

COVID-19 pandemic extracted the best opportunity for the cooperative when the cooperative faced challenges in transporting their products due to the lockdown.

VADCO enlisted on-line as an agricultural supplier in the municipality. Orders came in and sales became better. The cooperative was producing 30 to 50 liters a day through manual operation. Yet, some of the orders were refused due to lack of facilities and manpower. Sales recorded in March was P26,871 and in April P67,399.00.

Before becoming a COOP SEED beneficiary, VADCO was only a supplier of raw milk to a private processing plant. After COOP-SEED Program, VADCO grew to a small scale milk producer and processor. With the assistance and technology given to them, they have learned that they can be an entrepreneur of their own.

The story of VADCO is no different from other large cooperatives. Great things start from small beginnings. The officers, management staff and members now realized the importance of being a Cooperative. More assistance are stored ahead from the Local Government Unit of Valencia, national government agencies and big brother cooperative through the assistance of the Cooperative Development Authority.

They secured a working pass from the City Hall for the cooperative employees to enable them to report regularly.
