



CDA AND COOPERATIVES FORGE MOA FOR KOOP KAPATID PROGRAM

The Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) Region VI Extension Office together with two big brother cooperatives, namely Silay Community and Government Employees Multi-Purpose Cooperative (SCGEM) and Government Employees Multi-Purpose Cooperative of Silay City (GEMSC) forged Memorandum of Agreements (MOA) with their respective beneficiary-cooperatives June 10 and June 11, 2022 at Silay City, Negros Occidental, respectively.

Present during the signing of the MOA last June 10, 2022 were Regional Director Dr. Nora P. Patron, Atty. Romelia Alpasan-Base, Ms. Jona Gepilga and Mr. Vincent J. Unarce for CDA while Silay Community and Government Employees Multi-Purpose Cooperative and its small brother cooperative, Hda. Nacab Agrarian Reform Cooperative, were headed by Chairperson Dela Ledesma and Chairperson Mario Agular Sr., respectively.



While last June 11, 2022, CDA together with GEMSC officers headed by Chairperson Noel Doloriac signed the Koop Kapatid Program MOA with its two small brother cooperatives, namely San Vicente 1 Agrarian Reform Cooperative and Progreso Agrarian Reform Cooperative also at Silay City, Negros Occidental. The small brother cooperatives were headed by Chairperson Janet C. Alayon and Chairperson Jojo Gonzales, respectively.



As stated in CDA Memorandum Circular 2020-02, Koop Kapatid refers to the program of the CDA formerly known as "Small Brother-Big Brother Program" wherein the Big Brother extends assistance to "Small Brother", giving importance on education, and other technological advancement.
