### PAGUNOVA (Palmera-Gumaok-Novaliches) Transport and Multi-purpose Service Cooperative conducts its Grand Launching and Oath Taking of Officers and Committees for 2023

It was a sunny day at the Brgy. Sapang Palay Proper, City of San Jose Del Monte. Ten (10) new units of modernized jeepney and two (2) new units of bus were parked in front of the Gumamela Hall Convention Center. These units were newly purchased by the PAGUNOVA Transport and Multi-purpose Service, in line with the government's transport modernization program.



PAGUNOVA Transport and Multi-purpose Service Cooperative invited representatives from the cooperative sector and its government partners. of CSJDM; other representatives from government partners like the Provincial Cooperative and Enterprise Office (PCEDO), the City Cooperative Development Office (CCDO) of CSJDM, and the Local Government Unit (LGU) of CSJDM; and fellow cooperative members of the transport service sector.

The event was also graced by representatives from the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), led by Usec. Joseph Encabo, Chairman of the Board of Directors, as accompanied by Mr. Nelson D. Evangelista, Assistant Regional Director of CDA Regional Office III.



The program was hosted by Hon. Alfredo, Barangay Councilor of San Isidro, CSJDM and started with a prayer led by Mr. Margarito Sello. It was then followed by the singing of the National Anthem and the CSJDM Hymn, and Opening Remarks by Mr. Leonardo Bautista, Chairman of PAGUNOVA Transport and Multi-purpose Service Cooperative.

Afterwards, guests were called to provide messages of inspiration to the cooperative. Each of them highlighted different points. Ms. Divina Quemi encouraged the inclusion of women in the transport sector. She also noted that the government's programs for the transport sector intends to empower the sector and its participants.

To strengthen the transport sector, different government agencies are working together to implement the necessary solutions. Usec. Encabo also reiterated the importance of proper leadership; that when leaders claim ownership of the organization, the organization starts to fail. He reminded everyone in the room that the transport sector's tagline is "bridging lives, connecting people". He also said that development isn't achieved overnight; it requires time and effort. He ended his message by assuring everyone that the CDA will support the cooperative and the sector all the way.
