For the second time around, the partnership between the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and Bicol University (BU) for the Training of Trainers (TOT) for Accredited Training Providers and Other Prospective Trainers of CDA took off last April 26-27, 2023, held at BU Main Campus, Legazpi City. It

mandated trainings on Fundamentals of Cooperatives, as per MC 2022-21, where the topic during the teaching demonstration of the participants will be derived. Other than that, the participants were also required to accomplish a training design and session plan. Lastly, the third day was assigned in the conduct of teaching demonstration where their works and output were critiqued and subjected to polishing.
