The purpose of this advocacy is to ensure individuals and communities have access to safe and quality-assured blood in both normal and emergency situations. It also aims to inform, educate and encourage the public on the need for the voluntary blood donation and to instill the public consciousness of the principle that blood donation is a humanitarian act. It has a total of 20 bags extracted from blood donors despite of the heavy rains in the morning.
