	Angelo Bugarin: from my end similar to the janitorial services regarding the PhilGeps Platinum Certificate
	Ray Elevazo: Yes, and Secreatriat please take note of this PhilGeps Platinum Certificate.
	Then question from the chatbox was raised regarding the LSCC of one of the bidders if possible from the private since they have engaged with private clients before. As per Ray Elevazo, this matter will be referred to the secretariat for their comments.
	Jonal Delos Reyes: With government and private contracts, however, with ongoing contracts, it was not stated there is government or private in a single largest contract. So private LSCC is allowed.
	Another question was raised regarding the admin fee if GPPB or DOLE, standard 20%?
	Jonal Delos Reyes: This was resolved already before it should have been GPPB. That DOLE DO 150-16 was acknowledged for the 20% admin fee.
	Rommel Jhay Lagadan (Circa): question if the existing statement will be attached by contracts or only the statements?
	Jonal Delos Reyes: only statements must be verified by the TWG.
	Rommel Jhay Lagadan (Circa): if the number of days to be used is 395 from 394.4? and if the COLA is still applicable. And if the 610 daily wage?
	Jonal Delos Reyes: noted on this. Regarding the daily wage what is the DW for the NCR. And the Omnibus is until number 10.

	Clarification
	Clarifications also about the SSS premiums were also to be discussed further and to be clarified. But considerations are to be taken if what is the latest SSS requirement.
	DA Ray Elevazo also mentioned that as per the TWG Atty. Owen stressed that the Wish of SSS is voluntary but it was emphasized by the one raising the question that it is mandatory.
	DA Elevazo asked for the executive session to tackle some points to be discussed by the BAC Members and the bidders can log out for this purpose.
DISCUSSIONS DURING THE EXECUTIVE SESSION	During the executive session, queries raised during the conference were discussed and should have been clarified especially concerning the mandatory SSS contributions.
