A DDoS attack is a malicious attempt to overwhelm a target server or network with excessive internet traffic, akin to a traffic jam on a highway. To combat accessibility and availability issues, Content Delivery Networks (CDNs) and DDoS Mitigation Tools are necessary in modern technology. CDNs improve speed, safety, and reliability of information systems, while DDoS Mitigation ensures uninterrupted availability. Signs of a DDoS attack include suspicious traffic patterns and unusual spikes in requests. CDNs and DDoS tools offer benefits like faster webpage loading, enhanced security, increased availability, optimization services, and cost savings through reduced bandwidth usage. 2.2. The general objective of this project is to procure a one-year subscription to CDA’s Content Delivery Network and Distributed Denial-of-Service mitigation tool. 3. SUBSCRIPTION PERIOD 3.1.
