The Secretariat also showed the CDA Board Resolution No. 011 series of 2024 which approved the procurement of 170 units of digital 2 in 1 corn mill combined rice mill.

Pacao	Requested that it be stated in the minutes that the Board Resolution No. 011 series of 2024 is only for the procurement of 170 units of digital 2 in 1 corn mill combined rice mill and does not include the technical specifications. Mr. Chong	Regarding availability of delivery, does this mean that 100% of the 170 units should be available?	Mr. Bajado clarified that during the Post Qualification, the supplier shall issue a certification that it has 170 available farm machineries in accordance with the specifications. However, there should be at least 34 units available for inspection during the post qualification.
Mr. Chong	Is it possible to have in the Bid Supplement that the available units for inspection be at least 50% of 170?	that the Secretariat will
Engr. Mari	Regarding the technical specifications, before we started, it was stated in the bid documents the Generic Procurement Manual, but upon checking, she said the technical specifications come from the AMTEC test result because included here is the test material. She also mentioned that in the government procurement, the Phil Agricultural Engineering Standards (PAES 206:2015) is being followed. She further mentioned that it is important to have the Hulling Efficiency, Milling Recovery Index, and Percent Head Rise Index which were not included in

Mr. Malapit	Inquired under what regulation are these required?	Engr. Dullas mentioned the Bureau of Agricultural and Fisheries Engineering (BAFE) since CDA also requires permit to operate.
Engr. Dullas	If we will look at the technical specifications, they were tailor fit to a specific brand. If you will check with AMTEC, it will show a specific model.	Mr. Malapit replied that the technical specifications are the minimum qualifications but the bidders can offer machines with better specifications at cheaper price.
Mr. Malapit	Inquired what should be included in the technical specifications	Engr. Dullas replied that their company is ok with the min. input capacity, output capacity, and milling capacity but the other specifications are specific to one brand.
Asec. Disimban	The technical specifications were based on the consultation with farmer cooperatives. We wanted to buy machines that the cooperatives needed and requested. Especially since the cooperatives are in farflung areas, they need portable machines.	
Atty. Pacao	With the explanation of the end-user, the BAC will still take note of the comment of the prospective bidder. The technical specifications should not be identified with a specific brand. We will just look into how we can present the technical specifications so	Engr. Dullas added that the hulling efficiency should be 75% as per PAES standard. However the current technical specifications show a hulling efficiency of only 10%.

Mr. Malapit replied that adaptability is the basic requirement for this project because the cooperatives are located in marginalized geographic areas.
	Engr. Dullas	The technical specifications show that the machines will be used for approx. 24 cavans per day which is too little.	Mr. Malapit mentioned that the end-users are micro coops not large commercial users. They do not have big volumes.
	Engr. Dullas	Mentioned about genset which can be used in far flung areas where there is min electricity.	
	Mr. Elevazo	The comments will be taken seriously and will be tackled by the BAC during the executive sessions. The reason why we will add an agricultural engineer in the TWG because we take the comments seriously.
