RESOLUTION DECLARING A FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE PROJECT SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF 120 UNITS OF LAPTOP COMPUTERS FOR FY 2025 UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER CDA-GOODS-2026-01

WHEREAS, the Head Office Bids and Awards Committee (HO-BAC) conducted a Pre-Procurement Conference for the project, **“Supply and Delivery of 120 Units of Laptop Computers for FY 2025”** with Project ID No. CDA-GOODS-2026-01, with Purchase Request No. 2025-314 and an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Six Million Four Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (P6,480,000.00)** only on December 22, 2025, January 19, 2026, January 22, 2026, February 9, 2026, and February 13, 2026 ;

WHEREAS, the HO-BAC posted its Invitation to Bid for the aforesaid procurement project on the PhilGEPS website, CDA official website, and at the Head Office Bulletin Board located at the Main Lobby on February 18, 2026, in accordance with the posting requirements under the procurement rules;

WHEREAS, the HO-BAC likewise invited representatives from the Commission on Audit (COA), Procurement Service – Department of Budget and Management (PS-DBM), Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI), and National Confederation of Cooperatives (NATCCO) to serve as observers during the entire bidding process;

WHEREAS, the Pre-Bid Conference for the project was conducted via videoconferencing on February 27, 2026, in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 12009 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), to provide prospective bidders with the opportunity to seek clarification on the technical specifications, scope of work, and other requirements of the procurement, as well as to address issues and concerns relating to the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, seven (7) prospective bidders attended the said conference, namely, Joneco Tech Marketing Corp., Quartz Business Products Corporation, Next Innovation, Inc., Accent Micro Technologies, Inc., Advance Solutions, Inc., GPL Trading OPC, and IDENICO Computer Corp.;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned prospective bidders informed the HO-BAC that the global laptop supply market continues to be affected by supply chain disruptions, semiconductor production constraints, and the sustained increase in global demand for information technology equipment;

WHEREAS, these prevailing market conditions have implications on the availability of laptop units, pricing stability, and delivery lead times in both the international and local markets;



WHEREAS, in view thereof, the prospective bidders raised concerns as to whether the ABC would be sufficient in light of the high technical specifications required for the project, as well as the prescribed delivery period of sixty (60) days;

WHEREAS, such concerns were raised for the consideration of the HO-BAC in the evaluation of the procurement requirements, cost estimates, and implementation schedule for the project;

WHEREAS, taking into account the concerns raised by the prospective bidders, the HO-BAC convened on March 3, 2026 to deliberate on the matters raised during the Pre-Bid Conference and to determine the appropriate course of action in accordance with the applicable procurement rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, Section 70.c.i. of the IRR of Republic Act No. 12009 provides that the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract for justifiable and reasonable grounds, such as when the physical and economic conditions have significantly changed so as to render the project no longer economically, financially, or technically feasible;

WHEREAS, after due deliberation, the HO-BAC deemed it necessary to review and reassess the procurement requirements, including the ABC, technical specifications, and delivery period, in order to ensure that the procurement remains feasible, competitive, and responsive to prevailing market conditions;

WHEREAS, considering the foregoing circumstances and the concerns raised by the prospective bidders regarding the sufficiency of the ABC and the feasibility of complying with the technical specifications and delivery requirements, the HO-BAC finds sufficient basis to recommend the declaration of a **Failure of Bidding** for the subject procurement project.

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** the following:

- a) To declare a failure of bidding for the project "Supply and Delivery of 120 Units of Laptop Computers for FY 2025" under Contract No. CDA-GOODS-2026-01;
- b) To notify all prospective bidders of the declaration of failure of bidding for the subject procurement project;
- c) To recommend the conduct of a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and technical specifications stated in the Bidding Documents, including the cost estimates and delivery requirements;
- d) To request the End-User, the Information and Communications Technology Division (ICTD), to review and submit the revised details in the Purchase Request, particularly the unit cost and total project cost, to reflect the appropriate procurement cost based on prevailing market conditions and the allocation indicated in the Annual Procurement Plan as continuing funds from FY 2025; and

- e) To conduct a re-bidding with re-advertisement and/or posting, in accordance with the provisions of Section 50.3 of the IRR of Republic Act No. 12009.
